## What To Bring:

- One Medium size suitcase - no more than 50 pounds (will be checked for free) plus one (pocketbook - standard backpack - computer case)
- Appropriate (see below for description) clothing for 2 days of traveling and 5 days of ministry and for mild weather. Will need a day and night outfit for 5 days in Lima. Two pairs of shoes (sneaker and casual). \*Hats are encouraged for daytime and sunscreen (must meet 3-1-1 regulations below if using carry-on).

\*Appropriate clothing for **boys** will be standard t-shirts, with sleeveless only permitted during daytime. **Girls** will need t-shirts, with sleeveless only permitted during daytime, and shorts must be fingertip length.

## **Carry-Ons**

- **Toiletries & Meds - You are allowed to bring one small bag of liquids, aerosols, gels, creams and pastes through the checkpoint. These are limited to 3.4 ounces or less per container. Consolidating these containers in the small bag separate from your carry-on baggage enables TSA officers to screen them quickly.**

**3-1-1 for carry-ons.** Liquids, gels, aerosols, creams and pastes must be 3.4 ounces (100ml) or less per container; must be in 1 quart-sized, clear, plastic, zip-top bag; **1 bag per passenger** placed in screening bin. The bag limits the total liquid volume each traveler can bring.

## **Other Items Info:**

- Towels, soaps, and shampoos, are provided by hotel. You may bring your own as long as they follow the 3-1-1 rule as noted above.
- Money (cash only - students are encouraged to exchange money only as needed so monetary value is not lost, as exchange rates fluctuate). There are many places to exchange money where we will be traveling.
- All food will be covered and students will be able to purchase snacks and drinks on own while there. We will provide plenty of water.
- Any other inquiries may be resolved by using the “**MyTSA**” app. or Website ([tsa.gov](https://www.tsa.gov)).
- **PASSPORT** & any other form of ID. I will have photo copies of each passport.
- **Bibles** are and journals needed.

***\*I will have my cell phone available (304) 319-1457, and students will have their phones, but texting and calls will be discouraged during ministry times.***

***Also, most items that may be overlooked and forgotten, can be purchased while in Peru.***

## **Updated Peru Missions Trip Checklist:**

- Sweatshirts for evenings.
- Bathing suits for hotel pool.
- Church clothes for one service.
  - Boys - polo shirts or casual button down. Jeans or nice dress shorts (no t-shirts).
  - Girls - casual tops or dresses. Jeans or nice dress shorts (no t-shirts).
- Any extra clothes from family members or yourself (lightly worn - good shape) you can fit in your checked bag (Remember, no more than 50 lbs). Mostly clothes for spring and summer weather, they have mild winters.
- US dollars are accepted by most places we will be in Peru. There are also ATM machines that where we are that dispense US dollars and our hotel does exchange US dollars to Sol.
- Visa credit cars are widely accepted where we will be and some places accept MasterCard.
- Average temperatures while we are there are between 58 - 75 degrees.

## **Other Information:**

- Transportation for this trip will be provided by local bus company.
- We will be doing outreach to local villages with YWAM Director Cesar and his team.
  - Translators (3-5 will be with us).
  - Purchasing children's vitamins in Peru and separating into sandwich bags for distribution.
  - Distributing readers.
  - Distributing clothes.
  - Drama presentations - Will select 2 or 3.
  - Playing with local children.
- Orphanage ministry.
- Children's hospital ministry.
- Evangelism at local university.
  - Translators (3-5 will be with us).
  - Sharing the gospel through conversation (GOSPEL).
